

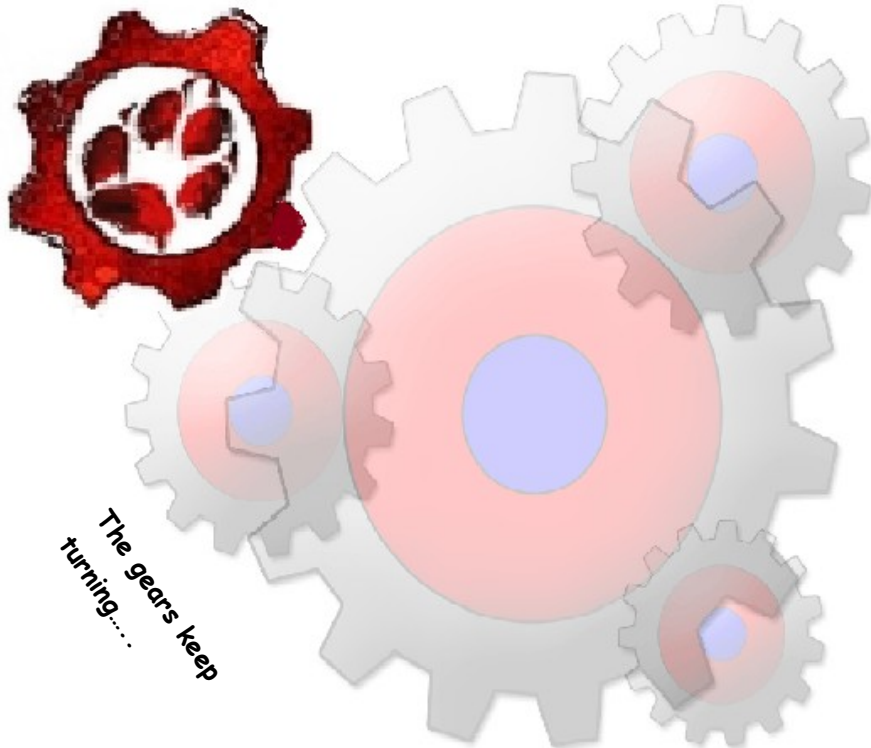

Meet Our Guests for ShadowCon 2013!

Col. Louis Zocchi, ShadowCon's Gaming Guest of Honor has been involved with Adventure games since 1955, he play tested them for Avalon Hill, and later designed its Luftwaffe game, which remained on the top ten sellers list for the next 20 years. Luftwaffe has been redesigned and refined, and is currently available from Zocchi sales booth and Strategy & Tactics magazine for \$50. Zocchi's Basic and Advanced Figther Combat game recieved an Origins award for designing the Best Air To Air Combat Rulkes Of All Time. His Star Fleet Battle Manual won the British Games Day Award and was nominated for an Origins Award. Zocchi designed the 100 sided die and in 2009, he was given another Origins Award for co-designing the D-Total die that generates numbers for 18 different dice shapes. In 1987 Zocchi was inducted into the Adventure Gaming Hall of Fame and lectured every year at Origins and Gencon from 1990 to 2005. More than 124,000 gamers have gone to Youtube, and typed in Louiszocchi, to see his 20 minute explanation of why all dice are not created equal. If you watch both parts, you'll discover what all of the other dice makers want to kept secret.
